To Whom It May Concern:

Greetings and Salutations~

I have been asked to write this letter on behalf of Sparta Leasing Group as a testament to their performance for Aggreko Event Services during the Vancouver Olympic Games.

Aggreko undertook the unparalleled task of supplying the temporary power for all of the Olympic venues. To complete this monumental job we shipped over 170 of our staff and contractors to Vancouver and Whistler starting in October 2009. While Aggreko is a world-wide company, we had no pre-Olympic presence in British Columbia and needed help in making sure we were doing our labor right. We enlisted the professional services of Sparta to ensure the HR needs, payroll, and health and safety of our vast crew were met.

The job was not an easy one for Sparta to keep up with as we had people flying in and out of Canada on a regular basis, making payroll difficult to accurately keep due to constant changes and updates, but Sparta did not falter once. The challenge of paying our crew in American Currency was also met without fail. Each member of our crew was orientated by Sparta as soon as they entered the country, which made for a clear understanding of what Sparta's role was within the scope of our crew's employment while in Canada.

The human resources and payroll division of Sparta were not the only exceptional services the company provided. With 20 plus sites and over 100 of our staff and 70 plus contractors the safety division worked full time to keep up. Canadian regulations for onsite safety are different than those in the USA, including the requirement to have safety officers for event sites. Coupled with the differences in codes, it was a bit of a change putting some of the requirements that were in the past considered unobtainable with a deadline looming into a strong practice. Sparta's safety coordinator had a gift of negotiations, and the unerring ability to know when to push and when to back down. Sparta ensured Aggreko's compliance for the entirety of our time in Canada. I personally was impressed given that I know how "focused" our guys can get on a project with a fixed timeline but Sparta personnel made sure while it happened and happened in a timely manner, it was most importantly safe.

Our relationship with Sparta did not end with the Olympics. We currently rely on the HR and payroll division for some of our remaining contractors, working in the US and abroad in varying countries. Their professionalism during the Olympics has caused us to realize what was initially going to be a project based relationship will benefit Aggreko for a long time to come.

I would not hesitate to recommend Sparta and any of the services they provide. They take away the massive headaches of the day to day running of business which frees the rest of us up to focus on the job at hand.
